API TERMS OF USE

This API Terms of Use ("API Terms") governs Customer's use of the application programming interface(s) for the DRB Solution ("DRB API"). If Customer or its Authorized Users and/or authorized third parties engage in any activities related to the DRB API contrary to this API Terms, DRB may, in its sole discretion, immediately suspend or terminate Customer's access to the DRB API.

Any capitalized terms not defined in this AUP shall have the meaning given in the DRB General Terms and Conditions.

Restrictions on Usage. Customer expressly acknowledges and agrees that the DRB API shall be used solely for the purpose of building and deploying mobile applications to end users, such as Customer. Third-party usage of, or third-party access to, the DRB API is strictly prohibited unless DRB has provided written consent to such third-party usage or access, as determined by DRB, in DRB's sole discretion. Any use of the DRB API that is deemed by DRB, in DRB's sole discretion, to be in contradiction of the foregoing restrictions may result in the loss of Customer's access to the DRB API, or the suspension or termination of the related services in one or more Quotes, as determined by DRB, in DRB's sole discretion. Should DRB suspend or terminate related services from one or more Quotes, DRB shall have no further obligation or liability to Customer as it may relate to the relevant services from the applicable Quote(s) or the DRB API.

Reservation of Rights. DRB expressly reserves its rights to: (i) from time to time, adjust the prices and fees associated with Customer's use of the DRB API; and (ii) from time to time, amend, change, revise, or alter these API Terms, which will become binding on Customer thirty (30) days after DRB provides notice to Customer. If Customer does not agree to the change, Customer must so notify DRB in accordance with the notification obligations in Section 14.4 of the Terms and Conditions within thirty (30) days of the notice of change and discontinue use of the DRB API until resolution. If Customer notifies DRB as required, then DRB may, in its sole and exclusive discretion: (i) allow Customer to remain governed by the API Terms in effect immediately prior to the change; or (ii) work in good faith with Customer to develop an alternative solution. In the aforementioned instances, upon renewal of the affected Services, it will be renewed under DRB's then current API Terms.
